ABOUT THIS WINE

Chateau Ad Franco's white wine from Francs, the only right bank appellation with AOP for white wines, is classified among the top 5% globally on Vivino. With manual harvesting, skin maceration, and fermentation in various vats, it stands out as an elite French white wine. The 8-month aging in French oak barrels enhances its body and aroma extraction.

TASTING NOTES

Creamy and very fresh with fresh, vibrant fruit. Lots of sliced pears, elderflowers, green herbs and dried lemons. Glossy finish.

VINIFICATION

Manual harvesting, skin maceration, and fermentation in different vats contribute to the wine's body and aroma extraction.
