Chateau Ad Francos Bordeaux Red is a unique wine crafted in a historic fortress. With vineyards on limestone clay soils, the wine undergoes gravity-led fermentation and aging in a cellar with natural spring conditions. ### TASTING NOTES

Elegant and structured Bordeaux Red with a smooth finish.

### VINIFICATION

Fermented in stainless steel thermoregulated tanks, the wine ages for 2 years in French oak barrels, guided by gravity towards the historic cellar.
